Effective immediately, the Rostraver Township Police Department is temporarily modifying operations as described below:

The changes in operations are designed protect the members of the Rostraver Township Police Department and the community of Rostraver Township from unnecessary exposure, and the potential spreading of the COVID-19 Virus.

- 1) Officers will promptly respond to emergency calls where imminent threat to personal safety and/or property is present. New response procedures will not impact high-priority emergency incidents! A high-priority call for service is any situation where a potentially serious crime is in progress, and not necessarily only when life is in danger.
- 2) Non-emergency calls may be conducted by telephone instead of in-person contact. In-person investigations will depend on the public threat level associated with the incident. For example, if a resident reports a property crime that previously occurred and a suspect is no longer present and there is no imminent threat to personal safety; an officer will obtain the necessary information needed to create a police report by telephone. The shifts ranking officer will determine whether additional investigative follow-up or evidence collection is required.
- 3) Investigations requiring in-person communication will be conducted outside in the open environment; therefore, complainants should be prepared to step outside.
- 4) Walk-in complaints at the police department are discouraged. The front doors at the Township Administration Offices are locked; therefore, restricting access to the police department lobby. To assist with inquiries, the police secretary or police officer can be contacted during business hours Monday thru Friday from 8am-4pm by calling 724-929-8811.
- 5) Fingerprinting services, including orders mandated by court, are suspended until further notice.
- 6) Pennsylvania State Reportable Crash Reports completed by Rostraver Township Police Department will be provided to your insurance company through U.S. mail upon request and receipt of required fees. In the interest of public safety, in-person requests for crash reports are temporarily suspended.
- 7) Driver issued warnings by the Rostraver Township Police Department for equipment violations, etc., should call 724-929-8811 to speak with the issuing officer or leave a voicemail to ascertain how the warning should be handled.

These changes to services will remain in place until further notice. We greatly appreciate the community's patience and support during this difficult time. When in doubt, please do not hesitate to contact Rostraver Police or 911 for guidance.
